What are the rules for party affiliation in 2020 in Kansas?

Any registered voter can change party affiliation by filling out a new registration application with the County Election Office or Secretary of State's office.

- Any application postmarked by Noon, June 1st, 2020 will be accepted
- Electronic submissions of voter registrations by fax, email, or on-line, will be accepted if submitted before Noon, June 1st, 2020.

From Noon, June 1st-August 31st, 2020

Democratic affiliated voter...

- · may not change party affiliation.
- may not disaffiliate from party affiliation.
- may request and vote a Democratic ballot.

Republican affiliated voter...

- may not change party affiliation.
- may not disaffiliate from party affiliation.
- may request and vote a Republican Ballot.

■ Unaffiliated voter...

- may affiliate with a party before or after June 1st, 2020.
- may affiliate with the Democratic or Republican party at the polls on Primary Election Day or when advance voting and receive a ballot for that party.
- may not change back to Unaffiliated until September 1st, 2020.

Libertarian affiliated voter...

- may not change party affiliation.
- may not disaffiliate from party affiliation.
- may not request and vote a Democratic or Republican ballot.

Brand new registrant, not transferring from another county...

 may declare a party affiliation by the deadline for new registrations, July 14th, 2020.

Currently registered voter who needs to change something besides party affiliation...

 may still change all other information, name, address, phone, gender, etc., by July 14th, 2020.

September 1st, 2020-June 1st, 2022

All registered voters may again change party affiliation with no restrictions.
